

Subject: Clarifications on scoring of toilets and cities not having JNNURM projects - State of Tamil Nadu regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that the Tamil Nadu Urban Finance & Infrastructure Development Corporation (TUFIDCO) through their e-mail dated 3rd July, 2015 have sought certain clarifications. The issues raised and clarifications are given below:
